THE SHOW COMMITTEE MAY ALTER THE SHOW ORDER TO ENSURE A SMOOTHLY RUNNING SHOW.

Rules and Regulations:

The American Dairy Goat Association sanctions these shows, and their rules shall govern. The junior and senior shows are separately sanctioned and are open to all ADGA, AGS, and CGS registered does. There will be NO preshow milk out. AGS show forms will not be signed.

Registration Papers:

The original registration paper must be presented at check-in. **Current ADGA guidelines regarding registration paper requirements will be followed.** All animals must be LEGIBLY tattooed prior to entering the ring.

Health Rules:

Animals showing signs of disease will not be accepted. In-state exhibitors must have an Arizona seasonal pass and Federal or Arizona premises ID must be entered on entry form. Out of state exhibitors must comply with all travel requirements specific to each individual applicable state(s) guidelines. An entry permit and certificate of veterinary inspection are required for out of state animals. To obtain an entry permit, phone the Office of the State of Arizona Veterinarian at (602) 542-4293.

BIOSECURITY REMINDER: Any does showing signs of illness or any due to kidd during the show should not be brought. Animals showing signs of illness should be reported to Show Chair.

Dress Code:

All people entering the show ring handling dairy goats in any classes are expected to be dressed in the following manner:

- Clean white shirt
- Clean long (below the knee) white or black pants or skirts
- Closed toe shoes

CHILDREN MUST REMAIN UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THEIR PARENT OR GUARDIAN AT ALL TIMES

NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS

Entry Fees: \$12/goat/ring OR \$40/goat if entering all four rings.

EXHIBITOR FEE: \$10 per exhibitor/breed

ARRIVAL: You may arrive on Friday afternoon. Everyone must be off the grounds by 9:00 AM Sunday.

CAMPING: Dry camping will be available on site with no fee. There is also a KOA in close proximity as well as several hotels.

PENNING:

This show will require most exhibitors to **SHOW OUT OF THEIR TRAILERS**. There is a large area to set up your pens around trailers near the shade where the shows will be held. There are a limited amount of pens available for \$5 per pen. **NO TACK PENS!** There will be 40, 5x5 pens that can hold all breeds. Each 5x5 pen should fit two standard does or 3-4 Nigerian Dwarf does. There will also be 10, 16 x 24 pens, with shade, that will hold standard Sr does. Pens will not be considered reserved unless full payment is received. There will be **NO bedding provided, and CLEANUP IS REQUIRED BEFORE YOU LEAVE.**

HOLDING AREAS: There will be an area under the shade assigned for exhibitors to set up their pens if they choose. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES** can anything be tied to fencing or posts near or around the shade.

POWER WILL BE PROVIDED by generators for those in need, but it is encouraged to bring your own.
